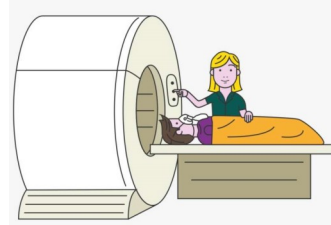
#### Senses

#### Radiographer

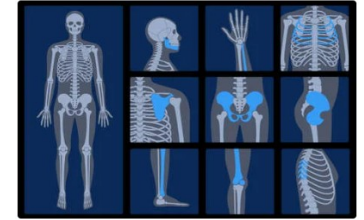
A radiographer usually works in a hospital. They use machines to 'scan' bodies to check for any health problems.

#### X-ray

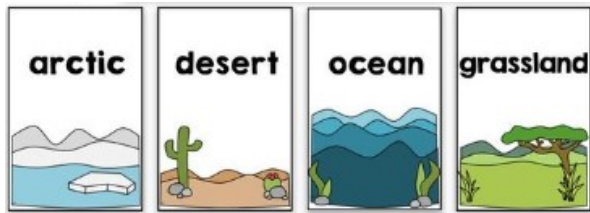
This is a scan taken in hospital to check for broken bones.

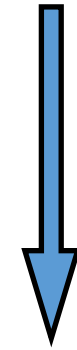

- I know that doctors and nurses work in hospitals and they can help me.



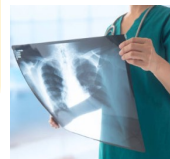
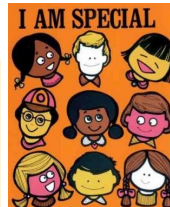
### Animals and friendship
