Christianity

An instance or manner of greeting someone



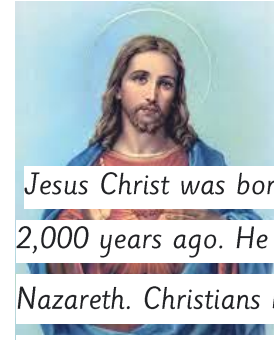
Prior Learning
