Learning in the early years happens through play. Children learn indoors, outdoors, alone, with friends and with adults. Some learning will be led by adults and some by the children themselves. Activities may also change according to children's interests and experiences. In FS2, we will experience the 7 areas of learning. They are 'Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED), Communication and Language (C&L), Physical Development (PD), Literacy, Mathematics, Understanding the World (UtW) and Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)



### **PSED...** As thriving individuals..

- We will continue to engage with our 'Ready to Learn' learning ladder and aim for 'great' or 'outstanding'.
- We will have opportunities to work in groups where we have to negotiate.
- We will share and collaborate within the classroom and in the outside area.
- We will think about healthy eating and ٠ healthy bodies.
- We will think how we could be kind to our local environment.

### C&L...As communicators...

- We will learn new vocabulary and • phrases as we work through our topic and include it in our play.
- We will ask questions about fiction ٠ and non-fiction texts.
- Retell a story ٠
- Offer explanations for why things might happen
- We will act out stories and introduce ٠ our own story line into our role play.
- We will use talk to organise our ٠ thinking and explain how things work
- ٠ We will develop social phrases

#### PD...As active learners...

- We will be continuing to use different equipment in the hall to support our gross motor development
- We will have further opportunities to develop our fine motor strength on our journey to being 'artists and writers'.
- We will use things like tweezers, lacing ٠ cards, marbles and threading materials.
- We will use tools like scissors, pencils, pens or larger equipment like spades.
- We will use different malleable materials and manipulatives.
