Key Concepts and vocabulary

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Community	A group of people who live in the same area (such as city or town).
Uniform	A particular set of clothes worn by the members of the same organisation or group of people.
Hospital	Where medical staff diagnose and treat the sick, injured or dying.
Equipment	Necessary tools, clothing etc. for a particular purpose.
Emergency Services	Public organisations that deal with accidents and urgent problems such as fire, illness or crime.
First Aid	Help given to a sick or injured person until full medical treatment is available.



Who helps us?

Police officer Maintains law and order, protects the public and their property.



Fire fighter A person that is trained to help in an emergency involving fire.

Nurse A person trained to care for the sick or injured.



Paramedic Trained to do medical work, especially in an emergency.



Doctor A person with a medical degree whose job it is to treat people who are ill or hurt.



Vet Someone who is qualified to treat sick or injured animals.

Dentist Qualified to treat the diseases and conditions that affect the teeth and gums.



If there is an emergency we will learn to ring 999 and ask for help.
